### Arrival:

#### *Arrival by train*

The arrival station by train from Germany is Aachen main station (Hauptbahnhof).

From Aachen main station to Hotel Buschhausen in Aachen you can take a taxi (5 minutes) to the hotel.

From Aachen main station, bus nr. 14 leaves every 30 minutes to Eupen: you should get off the bus at the Ministry of the German-speaking Community (DG).

From the bus station in Eupen the bus to Bellmerin / Hütte goes every 30 minutes to the lower town of Eupen, where you find Ambassador Hotel Bosten.
