Youth Leader Seminar 2011 in Budyšin / Bautzen

This year's Youth Leader Seminar of the Youth of European Nationalities (YEN), which took place at the Sorbs in Bautzen/ Budyšin in the Lusatia region in Germany, was also attended by representatives of the network RML2future. The week had the motto "VolunTEAR?" – volunteering and followed up on the discussions during

the Easter Seminar in Christianslyst at the Danish minority in Südschleswig, Germany. Together with representatives of FUEN, YEN used



the chance to raise awareness for multilingualism in Europe.

With a stall in the centre of Bautzen the participants of the seminar as well as the citizens of Bautzen and surroundings were informed about the smaller and smallest languages during a town-rally with language quiz and with 30 language versions of the slogan "It's never too late... - monolingualism is easy to cure!"

From 22 to 24 November the partners of the network were in Lusatia, Germany for the annual meeting of 2011. Besides a full working agenda, including the evaluation of the activities of the network in the year

2011 and the preparation for the next activities, the partners participated in the audio recording of the refrain of the new anthem of the European football championship of the autochthonous, national minorities, the EUROPEADA 2012, which will be organised next year from 16 till 24 June 2012 in Lusatia.
