A team from several multilingual regions where YEN is active will make a tour through central and southern Europe with a minibus stuffed with information and PR-materials about the multilingual regions of Europe, European organisations and (youth) associations, brochures, flyers, stickers, T-shirts, banners, posters, mascots etcetera.

The RML2future Promo Tour 2010 starts on 17 July and will end on 3 August; in total the young team from Youth of European Nationalities will cover about 4000 km.

17 July 2010	Departure from Fryslân via Germany to Hungary
18 July 2010	Arrival in Pécs, European Capital of Culture 2010. Participation in the European choir seminar "Voices of Europe", two concerts and activities on the main square on Friday (23 July) and Saturday (24 July)
25-28 July 2010	Continuation of the journey to Trieste, visit to this multilingual region, where the local Slovenian minority will be involved; amongst other things visit to the Slovenian institutions, shopping district, contact with tourists
28-29 July 2010	Being guest in South Tyrol: visit to the German, Ladin and Italian inhabitants; amongst other things press conference and activity on the main square, visit to the Ladin valleys
29 July-1 August 2010	Visit to the Rhaetians in Switzerland; participation in the Swiss hiking project "Get together – encounter of the languages" (www.get-together.ch)
2 August 2010	Visit to the Alsatians in France: fact finding and promotion Visit of the European Parliament in Strasbourg: open air; activity on the main square
3 August 2010	Visit to the German-speaking Community in Belgium and travel back to Fryslân

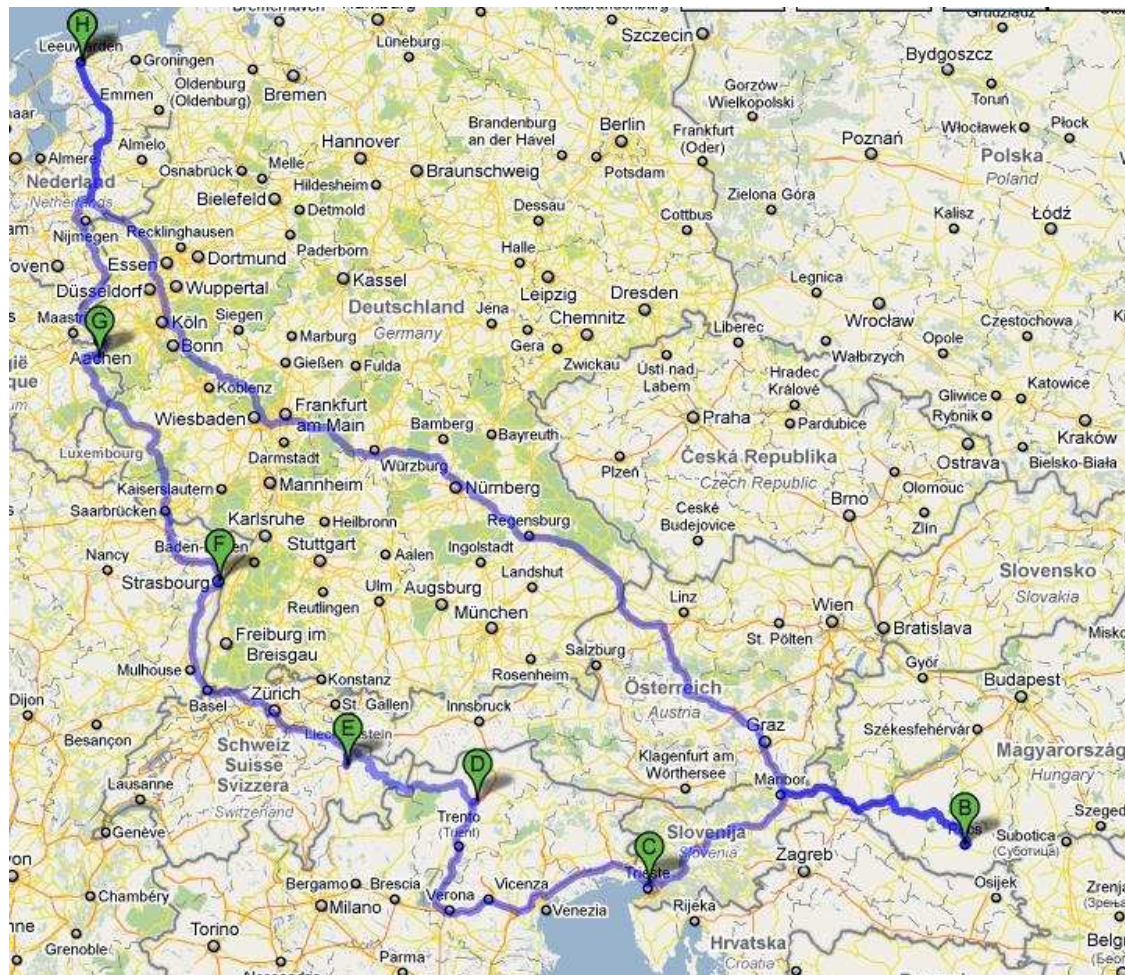
